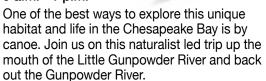

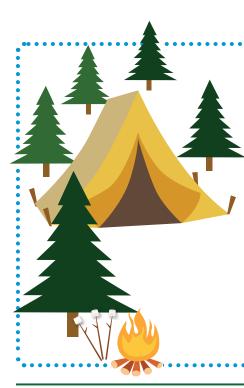
Nature and art combines in this creative program! Collect natural objects to create a stunning work of art. Participants should bring a shoe box lid that can be used to create their shadow box.
